Dodd Holsapple Statement From the Artist

I create work examining composition defined by Holsapple created the inventive and widely popular maximized color with deep attention to patterns, math and time to verify environmental awareness. Data driven visuals weave through color filled constructions with rigid measured definitions of space and a highly developed sense of balance. Organic elements mix with defined linear space culminating to amplify the contemporary landscape spirited by environmental and climate awareness.

> By creating a recognizable contemporary style my works are bursting with rhythmic and thematic technical visuals that document multiple moments into complex statements. The works are executed to form a memorable experience for the viewer. telling a visual story with engaging and unexpected arrangements that invite the audience to look deeper into the artwork and the environment.

Series Works (Ongoing)

The Solaris Series is dedicated to our night skies. For centuries, our night skies have mesmerizing and provided mysterious stories and unforgettable dreams. As technology continue to progress and science occupies more of our "dark sky", the blackness is less dark and the night sky is less spectacular.

The Reflections and the Pacific Series present Ocean Awareness in both threatened species and water temperature conditions. These works build from scientific graphs and exhibit dimensional representations embedded in the works.

Flora Exotica series engages the beauty of flowers in form and color. These works build incredible color impact with embedded organic forms depicting shapely moments in the garden and recognize floral stewardship and protection.
